**Course Description:** TLL 001-Communication Skills is a <u>non-credit</u>, <u>obligatory</u> course for FDP students, which aims to improve their communication skills with a special emphasis on writing argumentative essays. To this end, the course is designed as a "workshop" where everyone interacts with each other and it entails a "process" to achieve its goals. While in the short run, the course seeks to develop academic communication skills, it also has the long term objective of enabling students to utilize these skills in their professional lives.

### **Course Requirements and Policies**

**Evaluation:** The passing mark is 60/100. If you get 60 or over, you will get the grade "S" (Satisfactory) and if you get below 60, you will get the grade "U" (Unsatisfactory). Those who get a "U" will be required to repeat and pass this course before graduation. Students who do not complete the assignments and fulfill the responsibilities in the first seven weeks (finding an appropriate secondary source, forming an acceptable proposition, submitting the outline on SuCourse+ etc) will automatically get a "U" grade for violation of process.

Attendance: Attendance is obligatory. Students are required to attend all the synchronous Zoom lectures with their sabanciuniv.edu email address. Checking absenteeism is your responsibility, for this you can consult SUCourse+ / Attendance. If you miss a class without a valid excuse, 5 points will be deduced from your final grade. In addition, you will lose 1 point for lack of participation. So, you will lose 6 points for each absenteeism. If you have a medical report provided or approved by the University Health Center, or if you join an activity on behalf of the university, you will not lose any marks but you will still be responsible for the assignments. Playing with the phones during the lecture will also lower your participation grade. Students are also expected to come to class on time. If you are late by more than ten minutes, it will be considered that you have missed the first hour and your attendance and participation will be calculated accordingly.

Online Lectures: We will meet via Zoom at the original time scheduled for this course. The link is available on SUCourse+. Students are expected to attend the section they are enrolled in on its scheduled day and time via Zoom with their camera on. The cameras should be kept on during the online session and the microphones should be on when speaking. The online meetings will be recorded by the instructor. These videos will be accessible on SUCourse+ after each online meeting until the end of the semester to help students who have not been able to join the online session. Recording online meetings and taking photographs with any devices without the permission of the instructor is prohibited. Therefore, students are not allowed to record the online lectures with any devices, and they are not allowed to share the online sessions which are recorded by the instructor. If students act against these rules, they will be referred directly to the Dean's Office for disciplinary action. All the slides presented by the instructor during the online lectures will be available on SUCourse+ (under Course Materials / Lecture Slides folder) after that week's lectures have been delivered.
