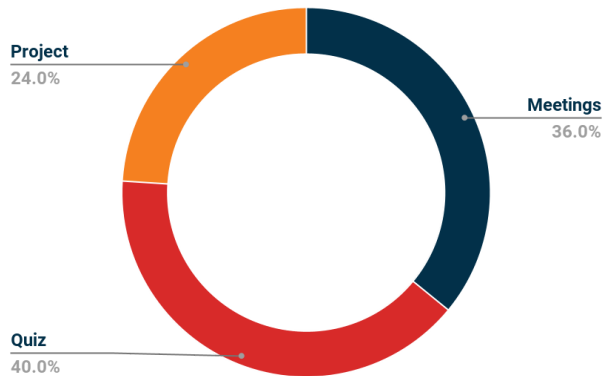
- Weekly topics and materials will be on Sucourse.

The weekly meetings will be held in class, there will also be online sessions if the student does not want to attend the class on campus. Students must complete the quiz before the discussion meeting.
- Each project group will have a supervisor.
