Course Description: PSY 201 is a general introduction to psychological science. In line with SU psychology faculty's main research expertise, the course provides an overview of social, developmental, and cognitive psychology as well as neuroscience. After completing this course, you will gain an understanding of basic concepts and theories in psychological science, methodologies used to test these theories, and major findings emerging from these tests. In sum, PSY 201 will introduce you to a scientific way of examining and understanding why people feel, think, and behave the way they do across situations, contexts, and time.

Lectures: Lectures have two components: assigned video lectures and in-class meetings. Please watch the video lectures before each class. Meetings will build on video lectures either through discussions and/or new lecture material. Please note that video lectures will not be repeated during in-class meetings, so it is essential to complete both components. Meetings will take place on Thursdays 12:40-14:30 at the **Performing Arts Center**. Each week, a different faculty will deliver the video lectures and meet you in-class on a topic of their expertise (see the schedule for details). Thus, you will not only learn each topic from the best possible expert at SU but also get to know and interact with all SU psychology program faculty throughout the semester.

In-class meetings will also be simultaneously broadcasted via Zoom. The Zoom link will be provided by faculty members a week before the meeting. Please make sure to regularly check SUCourse for the links.

Optional Readings: The Noba project (https://nobaproject.com) includes many freely available chapters on the topics we will cover throughout the semester. Faculty may also upload readings on SUCourse. Note that all these readings are optional (But don't forget that the video lectures are required!)

In-class Top Hat games: To review lecture material while having some fun you will play Q & A games using Top Hat in some of the in-class meetings (see the schedule for dates). You will earn points by just taking part in the game but there will also be a leaderboard with the top performers earning bonus points at the end of the semester.

Please sign up for Top Hat at https://tophat.com/. You can use the program for free as long as you sign up with your Sabancı University email address. Please make sure that you have access to the program (through either your computer or phone) during in-class meetings.

Essay Assignments: You will complete four assignments consisting of short-essay questions. Two of these assignments will help you develop your ability to relate what you learned in class to daily life. You will watch two documentaries and answer a few questions about each documentary using concepts you learned in the course. The other two assignments will encourage you to learn more about research conducted in psychology labs at SU and reflect on how psychologists may help improve human lives. Specifically, you will watch two panel discussions where faculty will answer questions on their ongoing research. After watching each panel, you will complete a few questions based on the panel discussion.

Exams: There are two exams to be held in class. Both exams will consist of multiple-choice questions. See the schedule for exam dates.
