Sabancı University, FASS, VACD VA505 Research Methods in the Theory of Artistic Practice syllabus

This course aims to enable artists and designers to theorize and to write effectively on their own creative output and projects, as well as to give them the ability to conduct research, introduce research analysis and design and develop theory in wider related fields such as art theory, art criticism, art education, new media, curatorial studies and the like. Students are asked to keep blogs into which they will post weekly entries describing their progress. The semester will commence with an inquiry into questions such as "why do I do what I do?" and "what is it that I do?" which will allow students to lay down the foundations to a topic of interest for which they will conduct an internet based search, starting from a "soft" approach and progressing towards in-depth research via Google Scholar. This search is expected to result in a literature review, which will lay down the foundation for an informed personal analysis of their chosen subject matter. The result will be an academic text of 4 - 5000 words.
